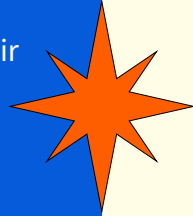


SEA SCOUTS BSA

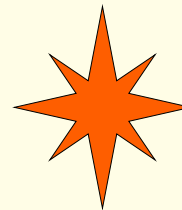

What is the AUXSCOUT program?

Sea Scouts BSA is the official youth program of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary

- The AUXSCOUT program focuses on opportunities to work together with the Sea Scouts
- Sea Scouts can join the Auxiliary at age 14
- Sea Scout youth and adults who join have full access to Auxiliary training, and can serve in a wide range of Auxiliary missions
- AUXSCOUT staff officers promote and support the AUXSCOUT program
 - A flotilla or division can partner with a Sea Scout Ship to provide training, vessel exams, and public affairs support
 - A flotilla or division can be the charter organization for a Sea Scout Ship

How can Sea Scouts help Team Coast Guard?

- Sea Scout youth and adults are potential new members
- Sea Scouts bring new resources, and likely have tech and media skills
- Sea Scouts are younger and can help extend the Auxiliary's reach to the public
- Sea Scouts can be boat and air crew
- Sea Scout units can provide vessels
- Sea Scouts are candidates for the Coast Guard Academy, active duty, and reserves



How can we work with Sea Scouts?



- Teach a basic boating safety course
- Teach Sea Scout advancement skills
- Invite Sea Scouts to meetings and social gatherings
- Do vessel exams on Scout boats
- Teach risk management, piloting and navigation, and marine and environmental protection
- Mentor Sea Scouts interested in Coast Guard careers
